Awards: To be eligible for any awards exhibitor must be a current member of HBHA. Membership may be purchased at show.

Jackpot Division: Single judged, 75% payout, divided at show management discretion.

All class scratches must be made 3 classes ahead of the event or the exhibitor will be charged for the class.

The grounds charge for anyone coming in early or staying late for both camping and stalls. Therefore, if you come in on Thursday evening or wait to leave until Monday, the fees will be added to your bill at the rate of \$20/stall/day and \$20/night for camping.

All out of state horses must have current Coggins papers and Health Certificates. IBHA rules apply. All IBHA horses must show registration papers at time of entry. IBHA Youth entries must show youth membership card. IBHA Amateur entries must show amateur card. All exhibitors in IBHA classes must be current members of IBHA. HBHA points will count when the owner/rider is an HBHA member. **Stallions must be handled by an adult.** Show management reserves the right to make changes in the program and to combine or cancel classes. The show management also reserves the right to refuse admission to any person(s) or horse(s).

Dogs are no longer permitted in the barns unless facility permission.
